The wood used for the base should be reclaimed or used from offcuts where possible and the finish (Painted / varnished...) depends upon the types of wood available.





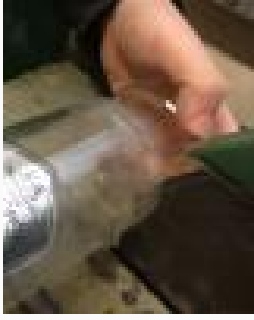




Materials & Equipment List

Materials: Glass Spirit Bottle, Electrical Tape, M8 Threaded Rod, Jubilee Clip, 3mm Aluminum Sheet, 12mm Aluminum Rod, Welding Rod, Brazing Rod, M8 Nut, MDF offcuts, Spray Glue, Craft Felt, Resin, Bulb Holder, Plug, Fabric Electrical Cable, Spray Paint. Equipment: Goggles/Eye Protection, Diamond Glass Cutter, Diamond Sanding Pads, Wet and Dry Paper, Craft Knife, Sand Blasting Machine, Hacksaw, Mig Welder, Welding Visor, Metal Lathe, Jet Cutter, Brazing Machine, Spanners, Wood Lathe, Scissors...
