Materials & Equipment List

Old Solid Wood Chair
4 or 5 2 litre plastic drinks bottles (clear)
2 sizes of Tee Nuts (For this project I used around 50 and sizes 7mm and 10mm)
Mallet
Pillar Drill (and appropriate drill bits)
Band Saw
Belt Sander
Sand Paper
Sand Blaster
Scissors
Set of allen keys
Clamps
Wood Glue
Wood seal
Primer
Spray Paint (white)

Making Instructions



After drilling holes seal, prime and paint in the style of your choosing. DESIGNER NOTE
